### **St. Paul Port Authority EPA Brownfields Cleanup Grant Proposals**

The Saint Paul Port Authority is applying for two \$200,000 Brownfield Cleanup Grants from the United States Environmental Protection Agency for activities associated with the cleanup of 3M Parcel-Central (900 Bush Avenue) and 3M Parcel 3-North (881 Bush Ave) in St. Paul. As part of the application process, the Port Authority is required to obtain public input to their proposal, which is due November 28, 2011. Starting November 7, drafts of the proposals and the proposed cleanups will be available for public review on the Port Authority's website (<http://www.sppa.com/3m/>) and at the Saint Paul Port Authority offices 1900 Landmark Towers 345 Saint Peter Street (arrange to review by calling Tonya Bauer of the Port Authority staff at 651-204-6228). The Port Authority will also discuss the draft proposal and consider response comments at two meetings: the District 4 Board of Directors Meeting, Monday November 7, 2011, 7 PM, 798 E 7<sup>th</sup> Street, and the District 5 Board of Directors Meeting, Tuesday November 22, 2011, 6:30 PM at the Saint Paul Police Dept. Eastern District, 722 Payne Avenue. The Port Authority will consider and respond to and/or incorporate all substantial written comments provided by November 22, 2011.
